INTERACTIVE SIMSCLUPTURE \$20,000

This interactive experience will provide visitors with an understanding of how white sharks and seals are utilizing the inshore waters off Cape Cod. A collaborative research effort is underway to better understand local white shark inshore movements, and this exhibit explains how that work is taking place.



THE IMPORTANCE OF CATS TAGS \$4,000

Technology improvements in recent years have led to exciting developments in tags. The use of the CATs tag is allowing us to have a 'Shark's Eye' view of the world. This exhibit outlines some of the unique observations that have been made through the use of this tag.


